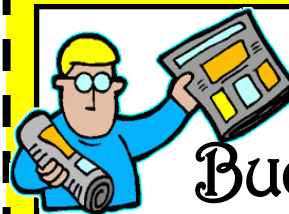

**Call to Order** at 7 pm by President Harris.

#### Pledge to Flag

**New Residents:** New residents Janice King & Philip Eagan on 745 Pirates Rest Road were introduced.

**Minutes** The minutes of the BHA Meeting on Monday, December 8, 2024 as published in the Buccaneer News were presented. Dave Cunningham moved to approve minutes, seconded by Joan Fusco. **Motion Carried.**

**Correspondence:** Jo reported that the Board had met prior to the homeowner meeting to review the Budget before presenting it to Homeowners. Motion made and seconded to accept the Budget as written.

**Treasurer Report:** Joe presented the 2025 Budget which he and the Finance Committee prepared. He explained the difference between the 2024 actual and the 2025 proposed which has about a 3% difference only. He further explained the difference in the ELS income as this budget was prepared prior to the remittance of the final \$5,000 payment from them. It will be included in the 2025 figures as the budget shows. He proceeded to answer questions from homeowners and thanked Linda for her assistance in the preparation. When no more questions were forthcoming, he also received a round of applause for his diligence and sound fiscal acumen.

Additionally, Joe announced that he would not be able to continue as Treasurer for the next Board, however would work with whomever was selected.

**President Report:** Arthur reminded everyone that there was a Candidates night on Thursday in the Hospitality House beginning at 6 p.m. He indicated that the current 5 candidates would be there to answer any questions. He also announced that while we still did not have an office, our files, and other various equipment is in Board homes and that we still had our phones which have been forwarded and are answered on a daily basis

**New Business:** The Budget is normally presented in December and voted on at the Annual meeting in January, however it is being presented in January and homeowners were asked if they wished to vote tonight or have it presented again in February. The general

consensus obtained by President Harris was they wished to vote now. Motion made by Mary Paul and seconded by Dave Cunningham to approve the budget tonight, **Motion carried unanimously.**
