June is the start of Florida's hurricane season and now is the time to prepare.

Be sure to buy plenty of water, waterproof sealable plastic storage bags for important papers and household items.

Have as much nonperishable food as possible on hand including canned meats, vegetables and fruits. Don't forget pet foods.

Use old milk jugs to store water for cleaning up afterwards and for use in toilets. Be sure to know your evacuation zone and nearest shelters. Pack a knapsack, backpack or any light piece of luggage to hold at lease 4 days worth of necessities.

If you have family members who live in a sturdy home that can withstand the winds be sure to contact them and make arrangements.

Let trusted neighbors know if you are leaving in a disaster.

This is not our first hurricane season and it won't be our last.

Using the training learned in the classroom and during exercises, CERT members can assist others in their neighborhoods and workplaces following an event when professional responders are not immediately available to help.

CERT members also are encouraged to support emergency response agencies by taking a more active role in emergency preparedness projects in their community.

Be sure the shelter is open before you

go. There are several shelters throughout Lee County. These are the closest. All listed shelters will not be open for every storm. Local radio and television stations will announce which shelters are open. We cannot predict how long you may have to remain at the shelter, since we cannot predict how damaging the effects of each storm will be. Food will be provided, but you should bring some food items with you for between meals, or in case you do not like what is being served. If you have diet restrictions or require specialty foods, you must bring those.

Hurricane Special Needs

The Special Needs Program is available to all Lee County residents at no cost. It provides shelter for those who live in a home and or area that is not safe from storm surge or wind and who have no other safe place to go. It also provides transportation to a shelter if they have no way to get there. You must register for the Special Needs services.

The Special Needs Program does not guarantee you will be assigned a space in the Special Needs Medical Shelter. Your application will be reviewed by the Department of Health and you may be

assigned a shelter.

Some things you should know about the Special Needs program:

You must update your information every year.

 Lee County will stop processing applications when the county enters the five-day forecast cone of a storm, so submit your application early in the season.

 Not every shelter will open. Only those safe from storm surge and wind for each particular

storm will open.

 Emergency Public Shelters are open to everyone and do not require pre-registration.

- Bring to the shelter things you need to survive, such as prescriptions, personal hygiene items, sleeping bag, cot, pillow, change of clothes, glasses, special dietary needs, books/ magazines/cards or other things to help pass the time while sheltering.
- Food and water will be provided, but we suggest you bring some food and drinks with you.
- Service animals are allowed in all shelters.

You can bring your dog or cat to shelter with you at the General Population and Special Medical Needs Shelters. They will be housed and sleep in a different area from you, but you will have access to them for feeding, walking and spending time.

What you need to know about the Special Medical Needs Shelter:

- The Special Medical Needs Shelter will be open for those with medical needs that require electricity, such as oxygen dependence, dialysis, ventilators, nebulizers, etc.
- You must pre-register for the Special Medical Needs Shelter using the application above.
- You need a companion/caregiver to accompany you during the time you shelter, as we have a limited number of staff working.
- After a shelter has been assigned to you by Dept. of Health, you will receive a confirmation letter and instructions to advise what to expect if shelters are opening.

You will receive a call to let you know when we are opening the Special Medical Needs Shelter.

Protecting your pets in a hurricane



In a hurricane, pets are subjected to the same hazards as people and have many of the same needs. Evacuating to a friend's home or petfriendly hotel outside of the evacuation zone would be a good plan. If that isn't available, you can bring your cat or dog to our Petfriendly Shelter.

Pet-Friendly shelters will be open in every storm; locations may vary.

Lee County Domestic Animal Services (LCDAS) manages this shelter. It is first-come, first-served, and there is no pre-registration required. You must shelter at the school with your pet (in other words, you cannot drop your pet at the shelter and leave). Owners are responsible for feeding, exercising and cleaning up after their pets.

Your pet will need a Hurricane Disaster Kit, too. It should include water, non-perishable food, medications and clean-up supplies. You will need a crate or carrier, collar and leash, and up-to-date vaccination records for your pet. Having a recent photo of your pet will be helpful if you get separated.

Remember:

- Never leave your pets outside during a storm.
- Never leave a cat with a dog, even if the two are normally friends.
- Confine and keep small pets (birds, hamsters, etc.) away from cats and dogs.
- Dangerous animals should be secured in special crates or cages.

LeeTran is geared up for mandatory evacaution



When a hurricane or other disaster requires a mandatory evacuation, many residents use public transportation to get to and from an emergency shelter.

At this time, the following applies during mandatory evacuation:

All LeeTran regular bus routes and transfer points remain in service, with the following exceptions:

- Bus fares will be waived.
- LeeTran will run shuttles from designated Transfer Stations to move evacuees to open emergency shelters.
- LeeTran will run shuttles from emergency shelters to Transfer Stations when shelters are closed.

Please keep in mind the following:

- Pickup times may be delayed due to increased numbers of riders.
- Evacuation transport service will NOT be provided into Collier County. Fixed route service will cease at Bonita K-Mart.
- Bonita K-Mart riders/evacuees will be transported to the Coconut Point Mall's transfer point.
- Buses will run as needed from Pine Island and Sanibel Island to designated transfer points.

Evacuees should keep in mind there is limited space on the bus and in the shelter when packing your three days' worth of emergency supplies. LeeTran will transport you and your pet (dogs and cats only) to the Pet Friendly Shelter **IF** your pet is in a crate or carrier.

LeeTran's Passport (ADA) division will activate its priority list, transporting those who require medical treatment first, and those who are deemed transportation-disadvantaged second. The bus fares will resume when the evacuation order has been lifted.



Protect your pets in our extreme summer heat



Do not leave them in car even with windows cracked for ventilation.

Keep paws off hot pavement. Most dogs rely on their paws vent excess heat in their bodies.


Watch for signs of heatstroke which include heavy panting, glazed eyes, a rapid heartbeat, difficulty breathing, excessive thirst, lethargy, fever, dizziness, lack of coordination, profuse salivation, vomiting, a deep red or purple tongue, seizure and unconsciousness.

Immediately move your pet into the shade or an air-conditioned area. Apply ice packs or cold towels to their head, neck and chest or run cool (not cold) water over them. Let them drink small amounts of cool water or lick ice cubes. Take them directly to a veterinarian.






