Minutes The minutes of the BHA Meeting on Monday, January 13 as published in the Buccaneer News were presented. Bob Lebrux moved to accept the minutes, Joan Fusco seconded.. **Motion Carried.**

Correspondence: The Board received a letter from Kay Cook announcing her intention to not continue on the Board, thus ending her term effective this date, February 10, 2025.

Treasurer Report: President Harris reported that Joe and Linda Arsenault had completed the financial update for the year 2024 to be presented to ELS in order to receive the final payment of \$5,000 which has been delayed pending verification of specific entries.

<u>President Report:</u> Arthur thanked the Board and residents for his past year as President and indicated he would not be disappearing into the woodwork. He would still be visible at Bingo and CERT and would be supporting the many functions by both the BHA and our clubs. Arthur also thanked "Sal Fusco" for stepping in as temporary Sgt. At Arms.
