Over the past several weeks, there have been changes to the Board of Directors. These changes were made with one goal in mind: stability. The current board is serving in an interim role to help organize our records, review our finances, and make sure our processes are clear and in order.

Our focus right now is simple. We are working to confirm that our financial records are accurate, that required filings are up to date, and that meetings and notices follow our bylaws and state law. These steps may not always be visible, but they are important to keeping our association strong and steady.

This board is not meant to be permanent. We plan to hold an election on Saturday, April 11 (pending approval), to elect a new Board of Directors. More information about that meeting, including nomination deadlines and voting details, will be shared soon.

We encourage residents who are service-

minded and who truly want to support the community to consider running for the board. Serving on the board is a responsibility. It requires time, attention, and a willingness to work cooperatively. If you care about the future of our community and want to help it run smoothly, we hope you will consider stepping forward.

At the March homeowners meeting, we will also ask members to consider a small bylaw change regarding the size of the board. Our current bylaws allow for between five and nine directors. We will ask the membership to consider setting the board at five members. A five-member board can be easier to fill and can help ensure meetings are able to reach quorum. As always, the final decision will belong to the homeowners.

Please watch for upcoming notices about nomination timelines, meeting dates, and voting procedures. We are committed to keeping the process clear and open.

Thank you for your patience during this transition period. Our goal is to leave the association organized, stable, and ready for its next elected board.



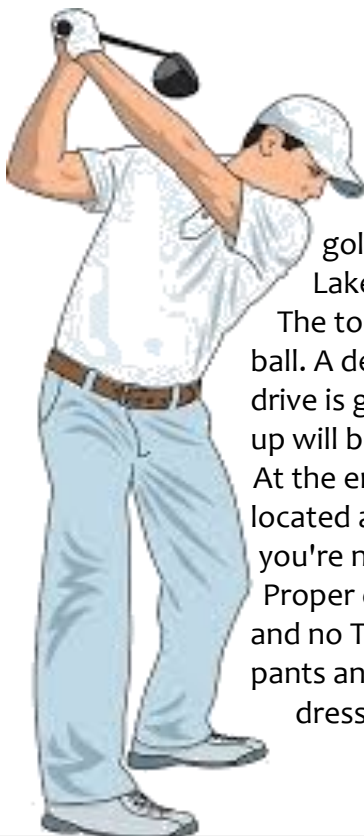

You must be registered to vote with the BHA Secretary or the Registrar at the BHA Office. All board members must either certify by an affidavit that he/she has read the governing documents, or will complete classes set forth by the Division within 90 days of election to the board, according to Florida State Statute 723 A**
